Minor amendment of a registered training contract

Examples of minor amendments include changes to:

- the apprentice's or trainee's name e.g. through marriage or by deed poll
- the employer's trading name
- correct a typographical error in a party's name or address
- a party's address

Evidence – An original document or a copy certified by a Justice of the Peace is required for a change of apprentice/trainee's name or date of birth. Please do not send an original document through the post.

Amendments will not take effect until the Department of Employment, Small Business and Training's records are updated.
