## Apprentice Trade Support Loans

Available to apprentices undertaking qualifications leading to occupations on the National Skills Needs List (NSNL), as well as agriculture, and horticulture qualifications in selected postcode areas. Eligible apprentices have access to loans totalling up to \$21,779 over the course of the apprenticeship to assist with the expenses associated with living, learning and completing an apprenticeship. School-based and part time apprentice payments will be paid at the same rate as full time apprentices. Apprentices can receive up to:

\$8,712 in the first year of their training (12 monthly payments of \$725.97)

\$6,534 in the second year of their training (12 monthly payments of \$544.48)

\$4,356 in the third year of their training (12 monthly payments of \$362.99)

\$2,178 in the fourth year of their training (12 monthly payments of \$181.49)

#### New minimum repayment threshold

Payments made to an apprentice through the Trade Support Loans program are repayable through the taxation system when the minimum income threshold outlined in the Higher Education Support Act 2003 has been reached. From 1st July 2021, apprentices will need to start repayments whey then earn more than \$47,014 per year under the Higher Education Loan Program (HELP).

## Living Away From Home Allowance

Apprentices/Trainees undertaking a Certificate II or higher level qualification may be eligible for Living Away From Home Allowance if they have to move away from their parental/guardian home for the first time to commence or remain in an Australian Apprenticeship, or are homeless:

First Year	\$77.17 p/w
Second Year	\$38.59 p/w
Third Year	\$25.00 p/w

Further funding sources are available for both employees and employers outside of the Australian Apprenticeships Incentives Program.
